


Completing Applications Graphic Organizer: Requesting Money Quiz

Read the scenarios below. Decide whether the applicant should request more money than the company offers.

Scenario #1:

Jon has just finished high school and is looking for a job with a landscaping company or gardening store. He loves plants, and enjoys working outside. He has never had a paid job before, but he has taken many science classes in high school and knows many facts about plant life. He is completing an application with a gardening store called Logan's. Scenario #2:
