



Here's an example of visual instructions about ending a conversation:

1. Wait until your conversation partner is done speaking.
2. Say something polite, such as *"I'm sorry, I have to run. It was good talking to you!"*
3. Use an upbeat tone of voice.
4. Smile and try to make eye contact when you say goodbye

****Remember:** Don't end the conversation if you have just been asked a question! Answer their question first, then exit the conversation.

OR

1. Wait until your conversation partner is done speaking.
2. Wrap it up! *"I think we might want to talk about this when we have time."*
3. Say something polite, such as *"I'm sorry, I have to run. It was good talking to you!"*
4. Use an upbeat tone of voice.
5. Smile and try to make eye contact when you say goodbye
