



Here's an example of visual instructions about ending a conversation:

- 1. Wait until your conversation partner is done speaking.
- 2. Say something polite, such as "I'm sorry, I have to run. It was good talking to you!"
- 3. Use an upbeat tone of voice.
- 4. Smile and try to make eye contact when you say goodbye

**Remember: Don't end the conversation if you have just been asked a question! Answer their question first, then exit the conversation.

OR

- 1. Wait until your conversation partner is done speaking.
- 2. Wrap it up! "I think we might want to talk about this when we have time."
- 3. Say something polite, such as "I'm sorry, I have to run. It was good talking to you!"
- 4. Use an upbeat tone of voice.
- 5. Smile and try to make eye contact when you say goodbye
