





### **Responding to Interview Questions** script:



If you don't hear the question, you can say:

"Can you please repeat the question?"

If you don't understand the question, you can say:

"I am not sure I understand the question. What do you mean?"

## **Responding to Interview Questions** script:



Q: "Tell me a little bit about yourself." Response:

Say 3 things:

1. Where you went to school and when you graduated OR Where you are in school now and what year/level you are in.

2. What your favorite subjects are OR What you are majoring in.

3.<u>One</u> sentence about your favorite hobby OR <u>one</u> extracurricular interest/club.

Then, PAUSE and LOOK: the interviewer might ask you a question.

#### **Responding to Interview Questions** script:



Q: "What are some of your strengths?" Response:

"I am very dependable. I always get my work done on time and I try to never miss a day of school or work." Then, PAUSE and LOOK: the interviewer might ask you a question

Q: "What are some of your strengths?" Response:

Describe one strength that is relevant to the job (a strength that will help you do the job well).

Then, PAUSE and LOOK: the interviewer might ask you a question about that strength.

**Responding to Interview Questions** script:



Q: "What are some of your weaknesses?"

Response:

Describe one weakness that is relevant to the job AND say the strategy you use to manage that weakness so that the weakness would NOT be a problem at work.

Then, PAUSE and LOOK: the interviewer might ask you a question about that weakness.

Q: "What are some of your weaknesses?"

Just say ONE:

"Sometimes I have a hard time following verbal instructions. When this happens, I need to write down what is said so I can remember the instructions better."

PAUSE AND LOOK: the interviewer might ask you a question about that weakness.



# **Responding to Interview Questions** script:



Q: "Do you enjoy working with groups or teams?"

### Response:

"Working with others can be hard for me sometimes because everybody has different ideas on how to get the job done.

But I think that it can make certain projects and tasks much easier to complete.

Sometimes it takes a lot of people to get the job done right."
